

of all the world's unreached people—a whopping 3.6 billion people—live in the 12 countries that we will pray for this year.





India's vibrant colors, immense crowds and overpowering smells captivate all who visit. India's population of 1.42 billion people means it has surpassed China as the most populated country in the world. It is home to 2,500 distinct people groups who speak more than 1,600 different languages and dialects. Onethird of the world's unreached people groups live here. Pray that the glory of the knowledge of the Lord will cover India as the waters cover the sea.



India is the 7th largest country (by area) in the world. India is bordered by Afghanistan and Pakistan to the North-West, China, Bhutan and Nepal to the North, Myanmar to the far East and Bangladesh to the East. Sri Lanka (from the South-East) and Maldives (from the South-West) are two countries with water borders.

Did you know?

- ▶ Hindi is the official language of India. We have films and resources in 263 of the languages spoken in India. Share one with a friend using the Jesus Film Project® app.
- ► According to worldometers.info, India has now surpassed China as the most populous nation in the world. India's population of 1,429,469,757 is increasing, while China's population of 1,425,639,528 is slowly decreasing.
- ▶ Many in India revere cows as sacred. As a result, cows are protected by India's Constitution; Over 6 million cows roam free in cities, on the roads and across the country.
- India was the first country to mine diamonds. In fact, until 1726, India was the world's only source of diamonds.
- ▶ India is known for its delicious food, like biryani: a dish of long-grained rice flavored with fragrant spices such as saffron and layered with lamb, chicken, fish, or vegetables and a thick gravy.



Praying for India

India, which recently passed China in population, is our focus this month. We have a lot to pray for but let's start with another brief lesson about the ACTS method of prayer.

Last month we focused on the first letter, "A", which stands for "Adoration." I like to call it "celebrating God." This month we are on "C", which represents "Confession."

"Confession" means we turn from our sins and turn to God for forgiveness.

One good way to illustrate this is to get a piece of paper and specifically write down each of your sins. Next, across the sheet of paper, write the words from 1 John 1:9 (below). Finally, tear up the piece of paper to represent God forgiving each of those sins and thank Him for His forgiveness.

Hebrews 8:12 tells us that God chooses to remember our sin no more. You never have to confess anything from this list again.

Week 1 Prayers



□ Day 1	Pray that churches in India will experience God's powerful presence in a new way, and that this will lead to many more people choosing to trust and live for Jesus. Pray for believers in India to commit to studying the Bible and living out their faith like never before.
□ Day 2	God's Word (the Bible) is a vital part of sharing the gospel. Let's pray for ministries involved in translating God's Word into Indian languages. Pray (a) for more people to join in the Bible translation work; (b) for the resources needed for the translation work; (c) for workers to translate the Bible into all languages so that everyone can read the Bible in their heart language; (d) for everyone who has the Bible in their heart language to read it with an open heart.
□ Day 3	Let's pray for Mumbai, the largest city of India, with a population of 21.3 million people. Pray for Christians who are effective and fervent in prayer to rise up across the metropolis. Pray that many people like the Bible's Joseph and Daniel would rise to positions of influence in the city. Pray for authorities to dispense justice fairly and quickly, especially to the poor and marginalized.
□ Day 4	Pray for India's media to make truth its highest priority. Pray for greater influence of biblical worldviews in India's newspapers, TV, movies and social media. Pray for Indian believers to engage as writers, artists, and journalists to share the message, person and cause of Christ in a culturally compelling way.
□ Day 5	In Luke 10:2 Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field" (NIV). Pray that the Lord of the Harvest will raise up laborers (full-time workers, associates, Christian leaders in professional workplaces, lay leaders, etc.) from and for campuses, workplaces, villages, and the digital space.
□ Day 6	Pray for all pastors and Christian leaders in India. Pray for their marriages and families, that God will protect them spiritually, physically, and emotionally from evil. Pray they will guide God's people with integrity of heart. Pray also that they would mentor and develop the next generation.
□ Day 7	Today, 54% of India's total population is below 25 years of age. Pray the government will effectively equip its working population with employable skills. May God give India's young people passion and a deep-seated purpose for living. May God pour out His Spirit on young people, and may millions of them turn to Him. May this youthful generation rise up to serve God and grow His kingdom.



Week 2 Prayers



□ Day 8	India has more than 600,000 villages, but thousands still lack Christian influence. As many organizations are working to make a positive impact, pray for increased progress as they plant multiplying churches among these villages.
□ Day 9	Leaders across every spectrum of society play key roles and make influential decisions. Pray they will seek the Lord's wisdom and be fair to every segment of Indian society. "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness." — 1 Timothy 2:1-2, NIV
□ Day 10	Pray that God, the Creator of the Universe, will show the people of India that He is not only powerful, but also loving and knowable, and that He desires a relationship with each one of them.
□ Day 11	More than half of India's population is under 25 years old. These young people commonly face loneliness, depression, suicidal tendencies, substance abuse and addiction to pornography. Pray God opens their hearts to Him and delivers many millions from their sin. Pray they will find hope and purpose in Jesus.
□ Day 12	As Jesus captures the hearts of students and calls them to make disciples of all nations, may they go into the world as gospel leaders. Pray that every student among the 55,000 colleges and universities in India would have an opportunity to hear the gospel and begin a relationship with Jesus Christ.
□ Day 13	Reaching leaders is critical to influencing cultures and bringing a Christ-centered transformation to cities and nations. Pray for Christians in the workplace across India to embrace God's call to professional excellence and to boldly share the good news of Jesus.
□ Day 14	Researchers estimate over one million children are involved in the sex trade in India. Children between the ages of 5-12 are the most at risk for falling victim to this industry. Pray for a total and complete end to sexual exploitation and human trafficking in India. Pray for the rescue of human trafficking victims, and for God to transform their lives as they come to know His everlasting love.



Week 3 Prayers



□ Day 15	Pray for a new short film series in the works that will help Indians see Jesus' life and miracles portrayed in culturally relevant animation and dialogue. Pray for God to grant wisdom to the script writers and cultural experts working on this project.
□ Day 16	The Indian state of Uttar Pradesh is smaller than the U.S. state of Michigan, yet its population is 70% of the entire United States! Uttar Pradesh is home to 191 unreached or unengaged people groups. May God release thousands of laborers to share the gospel and make disciples in this key state. Pray that God would break sinful influence here and that the people would turn to Him. May their hearts and eyes be open to see the glory of Jesus, causing them to put their trust in Him.
□ Day 17	Pray for the education system in India. Ask God to inspire teachers to be the best role models who always speak the truth in love to the children who look up to them. May there be excellent educational institutions in India where students learn moral values. Pray that children who are not currently enrolled in schools would have an opportunity to learn.
□ Day 18	Pray for the 65 cities in India with more than one million people. Pray for non-governmental organizations (NGOs), pastors, and marketplace leaders to partner together to change the spiritual climate of India, as they address civic, social and infrastructure problems in those cities. Pray that believers would be bold to share their faith with their co-workers in these efforts.
□ Day 19	India has the largest cinema industry in the world, producing 1,000 or more movies each year. Pray that those working in the movie industry would have a strong moral compass and desire to use movies to uplift, inspire and unify. Pray that God would reveal Himself to many of those in the industry. Pray that believers in the industry would have a powerful faith story and be able to influence many.
□ Day 20	May Indian Christians sense when the Holy Spirit makes them aware of their sin, and be quick to confess and seek forgiveness. May they also realize that God sees them as He sees Jesus: righteous and pure. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." — 1 John 1:9, NIV
□ Day 21	Pray for Delhi, India's national capital, nestled in the heart of north-central India. May righteousness and justice prevail in the political, judicial and social arenas of the city and the entire nation. May God raise up many people like the Bible's Daniel, Esther, Nehemiah and Joseph to take up positions of power and influence the country in a righteous way.



Week 4 Prayers



□ Day 22	Pray that Christians remain faithful in the midst of challenging circumstances. May believers unite and serve together for the good of their communities.
□ Day 23	Pray for the church in India to lift up the name of Christ, honoring Him in everything they say and do. May Christians gain a reputation for showing love to a hurting world. Pray for a growing love for God's Word and for believers to walk in wisdom, humility and strength, sharing the good news of Jesus in all its power and truth. Pray for God's power and protection against all evil.
□ Day 24	Pray people all across India will hear the gospel and turn to the Lord for salvation. "Turn to Me and be saved, all you ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other." — Isaiah 45:22, NIV
□ Day 25	Pray that believers will leverage social media and new technologies to build discipleship movements. Pray that an army of digital volunteers will mobilize to invest their time, talent, treasure, and technology to help fulfill the mission to make disciples of all nations. Pray that those who spread the gospel would be "wise as serpents and innocent as doves" as described in Matthew 10:16.
□ Day 26	Pray for the healthcare system in India. May healthcare workers turn to God and seek His help. Ask God to provide for the needs of the sick and open their hearts to know Him.
□ Day 27	The city of Chennai, on the southeastern coast of India, has been crucial in the traditional, historical, and academic growth of India since the first century. Today, it stands as one of the largest cities in India. Pray that Christian leaders will plant influential churches throughout the metropolis. Pray the power of the gospel will reach and transform all levels of society.
□ Day 28	Pray for Christians who have been rejected by family and friends to hold strongly to their faith and find comfort in community with other believers. Pray for God to raise up influential leaders like the apostle Paul from those who do not yet believe in Him. Pray the work of those providing legal aid to suffering believers will be successful.



Week 5 Prayers

□ Day 29

Pray that Christians would unite in caring for and loving their neighbors, no matter their beliefs. Pray that believers who come from different backgrounds would befriend and share Christ with their neighbors who don't know Him. Pray that God would reveal Himself to those who don't yet know Him, even giving them dreams and visions of Him. Pray for more people to read the Bible and, as a result, accept Jesus as the true Son of God.

□ Day 30

Kolkata is a megacity with about 15 million people. Less than one percent of those who live in Kolkata are believers. Pray that Christians will strategically approach the way they reach out to unreached people groups. Pray also for justice to prevail and for an end to corruption.

□ Day 31

Lord Jesus, we thank You for giving us a chance to pray for India each day this month. We believe You will continue Your work there until everyone has heard clearly about Jesus and been invited to follow Him. Someday we'll see how You answered our prayers. May heaven be filled with Indian people who started to follow Jesus in part due to our prayers this month. We give you all honor and praise.
