## STEPS



1

### CHOOSE



Where? A community close to you that needs to know Jesus.



Who? A person of peace to connect you to the community.



With? A Timothy to raise up to multiply.

### SHOW

Share the JESUS film with a group of 10 or more and invite them to return to learn about Jesus.


### START

Begin meeting with your missional community using the 3/3 discipleship training process.

### MULTIPLY

Send your Timothy to start his or her own Missional Community.



## KEY TERMS

### PERSON OF PEACE

A person who is respected, spiritually interested and willing to invite friends and family to see *JESUS*. (Luke 10:6)

### TIMOTHY

A believer who is teachable, faithful and available to multiply a Missional Community. (Timothy 2:2)

### MISSIONAL COMMUNITY

A spiritual community about the size of an extended family, that grows and works to multiply by starting new spiritual communities.

## 3/3 DISCIPLESHIP STRUCTURE FOR MISSIONAL COMMUNITY GATHERING



### Looking Back

Looking BACK means building community through caring for one another while celebrating God's faithfulness and each other's growth.

#### Care

Share from your lives (health issues, family, finances, spiritual needs, etc) and pray for one another.



#### Worship

Praise God with song, instrument, dance or testimony.



#### Cast Vision

Share how you can be better followers of Jesus and what your community can do to reach others for Christ.



#### Keep Accountable

Share how you are doing in obeying the Word and making disciples.



### Looking Up

Looking UP means hearing from God together. Using your tablet or smartphone, watch the next clip from the JESUS Film and discuss it.

#### STEPS

**1 Show:** Watch the segment twice.



**2 Tell:** Ask a member of the group to tell the story of the segment in his or her own words.



**3 Complete:** Allow the group to fill in any gaps in the story or make any corrections.



**4 Discuss:**

- What did you like best about the story?
- What can we learn about God in this segment?
- What can we learn about humankind in this segment?
- Is there a principle or command to obey?
- Is there a sin to avoid?
- Is there an example to follow?



### Looking Forward

Looking FORWARD means preparing for the mission by applying the lesson, practicing the story and praying together.

#### Apply

- Share in your group how you believe God would want you to respond to what we learned today.
- Think about a person in your community who needs to hear this story.



#### Practice

- Tell the story to each other.



#### Invite

- Share today's story with others and invite them to come to our next group meeting.



#### Pray

- Thank God for what we have learned.
- Pray for others in our community.
- Pray for one another in our group.
