Russia is a vast country. It spans over 6 million square miles and 11 time zones, making it by far the largest country in the world. Over 180 ethnic groups call Russia home. Join us this month to learn more about this diverse country, and to pray for those in Russia who don't yet know Jesus.



#### Did you know?

- Russia boasts two iconic facts about its history and culture! First, Russia is famous for its excellent ballet programs and performers. Then, there are the space dogs! In the 1950s and 1960s, Russia launched dogs into space to test whether humans could eventually go there as well.
- ▶ Russia is home to the coldest inhabited place on Earth: the village of Oymyakon. In the winter, temperatures drop far below freezing—as low as -90°F (-67.7°C).
- ▶ The Hermitage Museum in St. Petersburg is famous for its vast collection of over three million items whose origins span from prehistoric times to the present.
- ▶ Because of where it is on the map, Northern Russia experiences periods of 24 hours of light and 24 hours of darkness. The extended time of darkness is called "the polar night," while the long days of sunlight are called "White Nights."
- ▶ Russia is home to the longest railway in the world. The Trans-Siberian Railway, built in 1916, stretches over about 5,700 miles (9,000 kilometers) and crosses the entire country from Moscow to Vladivostok.







### Praying for Russia

Celebrating God allows us to reconnect with the profound greatness of our Creator. This practice, often termed "praise" or "adoration," serves as a powerful antidote in our fractured world. By pausing, quieting our thoughts and centering our focus on our Lord God and His divine attributes, we discover a sanctuary of peace, rejuvenation, hope and spiritual renewal. When you celebrate God, what do you focus on?

Here are some verses that I use to celebrate our wonderful God.

"Because Your love is better than life. my lips will glorify You. I will praise You as long as I live, and in Your name I will lift up my hands." - Psalm 63:3-4, New International Version

"I will exalt You, my God the King; I will praise Your name for ever and ever. Every day I will praise You and extol Your name for ever and ever. Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; His greatness no one can fathom." - Psalm 145:1-3, NIV

As we pray for the people of Russia, let's also pray that Christians across this land will frequently take time to stop and celebrate God.

# Week 1 Requests



□ Day 1	Russia is the largest country on Earth. It spans 11 time zones. Pray that God will raise up Christian workers across this great expanse and in each of its over 180 people groups.
□ Day 2	Certain regions and people groups in Russia have very few Christians. Pray for the translation of Christ-centered resources into the languages of these unreached people.
□ Day 3	In Luke 10:2 the Lord calls us to ask Him for more laborers for the harvest; that is, for more believers to share the gospel, lead people to Him and mentor new believers. Join us in praying for more Christian workers to help with the harvest across Russia.
□ Day 4	In addition to more laborers for the harvest, ask the Lord to bring trained men and women to lead these new workers. May they faithfully seek and follow His wisdom in all they do.
□ Day 5	Pray for Russian Christians to be filled with the Holy Spirit so they can experience the fruit of the Spirit in their lives (as described in Galatians 5:22-23) regardless of their outward circumstances.
□ Day 6	Using Scripture is a great way to pray for yourself, your family and your friends—not just for people far away. Pray this over your loved ones and for every Christian in Russia:  "Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things." — Colossians 3:1-2, NIV
□ Day 7	Pray for wise and faithful-to-God leaders and advisors at every level in Russia.



## Week 2 Requests



□ Day 8	Praise God for recently planted churches. Pray that God would raise up leaders and new believers to continue establishing new churches in His perfect timing.
□ Day 9	Pray the Holy Spirit will give Russian Christians boldness to live strong and daring Christ-like lives capable of bringing transformation to Russian society.
□ Day 10	Ask for God to open doors for women's ministry, providing relevant resources and relationships so that women throughout Russia can hear about God's great love for them.
□ Day 11	Pray for healthy churches to grow and multiply, and for current church members to help plant new churches in neighboring communities.
□ Day 12	The Lord often inspires believers to use new, creative methods to draw people to learn more about His truth. Pray for those God has called in Russia to create the latest tools. May they effectively reach every segment of Russian society.
□ Day 13	Pray that Russian people who do not yet know Jesus recognize Him for who He is and see their need for Him.  "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.'" — John 14:6, NIV
□ Day 14	Pray for Russian believers to be compassionate toward all people in need around them. May true love (as described in 1 Corinthians 13) flow out of their hearts.



# Week 3 Requests



□ Day 15	Pray for the families of Christian workers in Russia to be strong in the Lord and to lean on Him at all times, even when it's difficult.
□ Day 16	May Christians of all denominations, backgrounds and organizations come together as the unified body of Christ to fulfill the Great Commission: Jesus' command to go and make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:19).
□ Day 17	Pray for Christian outreach across Russia to grow and develop through creative strategies, training, mentoring and relevant, Christ-centered resources.
□ Day 18	Ask God for more church-planting teams to serve throughout the country, and that through them a church would be established within reach of every person in Russia.
□ Day 19	Many Russians are not seeking God and are living in spiritual darkness. Ask God to shine the light of His truth into this darkness and spark a revival that draws Russians to Him!
□ Day 20	The Bible teaches us that we have an enemy (the devil) who wants to keep Christians from trusting God. God wants us to stay close to Himself and to let Him fight for us. The Christians in Russia need to do this as well, so join me in praying God's Word for them.  "Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith"  — 1 Peter 5:8-9, NIV
□ Day 21	Pray that God will use Russian Christians to influence all levels of Russian leaders to make godly decisions.



## Week 4 Requests



□ Day 22	Praise God that He has enabled Christians to minister to others during difficult times. May God continue to lead them in caring for family, friends and their communities.
□ Day 23	Ask God to prompt Christians among Russia's various peoples and nationalities to plant churches that are culturally relevant, and that offer community and Christian worship to draw people in.
□ Day 24	Many Christian workers depend on financial donations from friends and churches to support their work. Please pray that the Lord, who owns everything, will amply supply their every need.
□ Day 25	Pray that the Lord will lead Christians to nonbelievers who are seeking the truth.  May they lead them to Christ, disciple them and train and mentor them in practical ministry.
□ Day 26	Different forms of media—full-length movies, short films, social media posts, ads—can all be used to share the gospel in culturally relevant ways. Pray for God to give believers wisdom in creating and using each of these different methods. May they help connect not-yet-believers with resources that explain God's love and salvation message.
□ Day 27	"How, then, can they call on the One they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the One of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!'" — Romans 10:14-15, NIV  Pray that God will raise up pastors and Christians to take His gospel across the nation of Russia.
□ Day 28	Pray for Russian Christians to continue sharing the gospel with those around them and helping younger Christians grow in their faith.

#### Week 5 Requests



Day 29 May God enable Russian Christians to continually choose to be loyal, faithful and dedicated to Him amid hard times.

Ask God to provide all the basic needs of Christian workers and their families in Russia. May they trust in the Lord and experience His care for them, even when times are difficult.

Lord Jesus, we thank You for giving us a chance to pray for Russia each day this month. We believe You will continue Your work there until everyone has heard clearly about Jesus and been invited to follow Him. Someday we'll see how You answered our prayers. May heaven be filled with Russians who started to follow Jesus in part due to our prayers this month. We give you all honor and praise.
